You are not limited to these

1. St. John Neumann
 - Assist the parish as an alter server or greeter
 - Help out at the flea market, fish fry or other parish events
2. Common Ground Free Store (Delaware)
 - Work at least 1 Saturday per month from 1-3:00 pm with 5-6 other volunteers re-stocking
 - Organize 2-4 clothing drives per year
 - Babies and toddler used clothes and baby needs
 - Children's used books and clothes
 - Adult used clothing and warm items like blankets
3. Human Society of Delaware County
 - Help with the animals. Walk dogs and help clean the facility.
4. CORE (located behind the library in Sunbury)
 - A service agency that helps young women in crisis pregnancies.
 - Help count money
 - Sort clothes, donations, etc.
5. P.I.N (People in Need)
 - A family service agency that brings together and organizes various ways to lend a helping hand to Delaware County residents.
 - Food Pantry – assist in helping keep the food pantry stocked
 - Holiday Clearing House – food, NEW clothes, NEW toys drive
 - Assist in light office tasks
6. Family Promise Service (this is a family service project)
 - St. John Neumann has partnered with the Vineyard to provide dinners to needy families.
