## Electronic Funds Transfer - Making Giving Easier \*

Historically, the collection envelope has been the accepted method of parish giving. Recently many parishes offer the option of electronic funds transfer (EFT) for those parishioners who are comfortable with transactions such as debits from one's bank account, charges to one's credit card, or banking by computer. For the past few years St. John Neumann has been offering the option of EFT, which has proven to be a safe, easy, and beneficial method of fulfilling annual offertory commitments for both the church and parish families for several reasons, including:

- There are no checks to write, no checks to remember, and no checks to lose.
- The parish saves money because EFT reduces bank costs and parish office administrative work.
- Offertory record keeping is more accurate because we get monthly EFT bank statements.
- Even the best intentioned parishioners can forget their envelopes now and then. EFT means your parish receives your commitment regularly, including the times you are away for vacations or work.
- EFT allows you to plan the amount you will give monthly and annually, rather than giving cash in the collection basket. Plus, EFT tracks your giving for tax deduction purposes.
